Also, <u>please note</u> that your password is changed by the SCA Member Chairman when he receives your check for renewal and updates the data base with a new expiration date, e.g. a two year renewal in 2011 will make the new expiration date 12/31/2013. Thus, if you try to log-in with the immediate past expiration year and that does not work, try using the NEW ending year based upon the number of years for which you renewed. Also, once you are logged-in, go to the bottom of the page and put check marks in the respective boxes (if any) that you wish to make available to be seen by other SCA Members.
