

2023 SCA Reunion Scheduled Tour Options

All tours must be booked via the reunion registration form. Each tour is on a space available, first to register basis. Attendance on tours supported by bus transportation is limited by the bus seating capacity. The SCA reserves the right to cancel a tour if a minimum number of riders are not booked by the 20th of Sep 2023.

1. Bus trip to Fredericksburg, Tx all day Thursday, 26 Oct: Fredericksburg is 66 mi. from the host hotel and an estimated 1-hour drive. While in Fredericksburg you will have the option of visiting the National Museum of the Pacific War located at 311 E Austin Street that opens at 9 AM and closes at 5 PM. The admission fees are \$16 for seniors and \$14.00 for military or groups of 20 or more. This includes admission to the George H.W. Bush and Admiral Nimitz Galleries. Or you can forgo visiting the museums and simply check out all the shops along Main St. Fredericksburg and have lunch in one of the many restaurants that cater to casual Texas Hill Country cuisine and authentic German cuisine. Some of you may be able to do both. The cost of the bus is \$40 per person and the bus seating capacity is 56.
2. Bus trip to San Antonio Missions National Park Thursday morning, 26 Oct: The park is located at 6701 San Jose Dr. about 20 mi. South off US Highway 281, about a 20-30-minute drive based on traffic conditions. It will take 2 to 3 hours to view all four missions. The bus will return to the hotel so you can have lunch at the hotel or in the surrounding area. There are no entry fees for the missions. The cost of the bus is \$25 per person and the bus seating capacity is 56.
3. Self-drive/carpooling trip to the Center for the Intrepid Friday or Saturday afternoon, 27 or 28 Oct: The Intrepid is a Rehabilitation Facility located at 3551 Roger Brooke Dr, Fort Sam Houston about 11 mi. and 15 to 20 minutes from the host hotel. The primary mission of the Center is to provide rehabilitation for military casualties who have sustained amputation, burns, or functional limb loss. Additionally, the Center provides education to Department of Defense and Veteran's Affairs professionals on cutting edge rehabilitation modalities and promotes research in the fields of orthopedics, prosthetics, and physical/occupational rehabilitation. There is no admission fee and the maximum participation on the tour is 50. **The date and time for this tour is currently set as tentative because of scheduling conflicts that are being worked on at the time the registration form is being finalized. If the conflicts can be resolved the date and times will be announced. If not, the tour will need to be cancelled. However, if you are interested in taking this tour, please annotate it on your registration form and we will keep you posted on the status.**
